Scholarship Criteria:

- Must be a Franklin High School graduate
- Must attend a 2 year college with plans to transfer to a 4 year institution or attend a 4 year university
- Must have a 3.0 GPA to apply
- Must have a score of 1000 (Verbal & Math) on SAT or 21 on ACT
- Must be enrolled in 12 hours per semester and successfully complete at least 24 semester hours per academic year (*not remedial courses and not repeated courses*) and earn an overall 2.5 or higher each semester. Dropping courses in order to maintain a 2.5 average will not be allowed for this scholarship.
- Financial need
- Citizenship, leadership

Scholarship Award Details:

- Scholarship will be given each year
- Half will be given in the fall semester and half in the spring semester with verification of enrollment & grades
- Student will present the Franklin High School counselor with a copy of his/her grades each semester before disbursement of funds.
- Scholarship money will be sent directly to the Financial Aid office of the college/university they are attending
- Scholarship can be used for:
 - Tuition & Fees
 - Books & Supplies
 - Room & Board
- Selection will be made by the Franklin High School Scholarship Committee

This scholarship will be awarded to one Franklin High School senior in May of 2017. This student will continue to receive this annual scholarship for a total of 4 years if he/she maintains an overall 2.50 GPA. A new student will be chosen after the 4 years are over. In the event that a student must forfeit the scholarship, the selection process will begin again with a graduating high school senior of the current school year, and the award cycle will repeat itself.
