Tyler M. Varvel Memorial Scholarship

This scholarship program is designed to recognize an outstanding student to be graduated from Franklin High School in 2016. The scholarship is to be applied toward post-secondary education.

Applicants will be judged on the following criteria:

1. The cumulative high school grade average
2. A written questionnaire
3. A 500-word essay covering this topic: If today was your last day on earth, how would you like to be remembered after you are gone, and why? Who and/or what influenced what you choose to say?

The scholarship will be in the **amount of approximately \$500**. It will be awarded during the Senior Awards Program. Only seniors in good standing may apply, and all applications **must be returned TO MRS. HUGHES BY 4:00 P.M. by FRIDAY, May 5, 2017.**

The winner will receive the scholarship when he or she presents proof of enrollment to Mrs. Michelle Mathews at the administration building.

Please note: Half of the scholarship amount will be paid in the fall and the other half in the spring. Winner must maintain a 2.5 GPA during the fall semester to be eligible for the money in the spring. If the winner does not pursue his or her education by enrolling in an educational institution during the summer or fall semester of the year in which he or she wins the scholarship, the scholarship will be awarded to the first runner-up, who must also meet enrollment standards.
