In 500 words or less, on the topic “Why I would like to be awarded the Wheelock Community Center Scholarship”.

Reynolds Elementary Faculty Scholarship

In 500 words or less include the following essay: “What are some important lessons learned in elementary school that have positively influenced your life?”

Scott Burgess Memorial Scholarship

Write an essay that is 1000 words or less in length that addresses the following:
“Discuss the role of patriotism in America today and why it is important to you.
Discuss the importance of the American soldier and what their service means to you.”

A 500-1000 word essay addressing : “How you, as one individual, can become aware of physical and social environments and how you would attempt to improve them.”

Leslie Sanders Memorial Scholarship

A 500 word essay:
“What This Scholarship Will Mean to Me”

Chris Jones Memorial Scholarship

Please write two or three sentences stating why you need this scholarship.

A 100-200 word essay on one of the following topics:
