

What amount is FISD seeking for this bond?

The FISD Board of Trustees voted unanimously to call for a \$7.4 million bond election to be held on May 2, 2020.

What major initiatives were approved by the board to be included in this bond package?

- Safety & security for all campuses
- · Renovations & improvements across the district
- · Program enhancements
- New buses

How much will this bond program cost taxpayers?

The proposed bond package will allow for a **DECREASE** in the tax rate by 8-10 cents. (Equates to a property tax decrease of \$160-\$200 for a \$200,000 property in the 2020-2021 school year).

How will the bond funds be distributed throughout the district?

2020 Bond Program Includes (but is not limited to) the following:

- 1. Safety and Security (all campuses):
 - Upgrades to PA/Bells/Clocks/Phones
 - · Upgrades to existing cameras
 - Additional internal and External Security Cameras
- 2. Comprehensive Upgrades:
 - HVAC (Heating/AC) (all campuses)
 - · Campus Kitchens (Elem & HS)
 - · Gym Lights/Lockers (all campuses)
 - · Parking Lot Paving/Caulking (all campuses)
- 3. Additions and Renovations:
 - · Elementary Playground Equipment
 - · FHS Greenhouse
 - Equipment and Furniture Refresh (all campuses)
 - · Franklin Ranch Concessions
- 4. Buses:
 - · 10 new buses/year
 - Rotate out old buses
